The decision whether or not to take a dual credit course and the number of dual credit courses to take is not a decision that should be taken lightly. We want to be sure that both the student and the parent understand the dual credit program and the possible effects it can have in the future. **Please sign indicating your understanding. Students wanting to take dual credit must also complete the Dual Credit Documentation on the back.**

- Dual credit classes are college-level courses and are taught as such.
- Dual credit allows high school students the opportunity to enroll in college level work and to earn college credit.
- Dual credit courses may decrease the cost of college tuition and allow the student to graduate and enter the workforce sooner.
- Dual credit courses are transferable to Texas public universities as well as many private and out-of-state universities.
- Too many dual credit courses upon graduation MAY affect scholarship opportunities.
- Exceeding 30 hours of dual credit can affect future tuition rates and financial aid.
- Withdrawing from or failing a dual credit course may affect your federal and state financial aid.
- Failing a dual credit course or making a D will result in Vista dropping the student from dual credit. They will not be able to reapply the following year.
- Dropping a dual credit course may affect future financial aid and will count toward the Texas 3-peat rule explained in the *HHS Dual Credit Handbook*.
- The grade of the dual credit course will be on the high school AND college transcript and will affect the college GPA.
- I understand that in order to qualify for dual credit for 2020-2021, the student must meet all of the Northwest Vista qualification requirements and the Harlan deadlines.
